Donate Life Florida Specialty License Plate Now ONLINE!



Donate Life Florida, the non-profit coalition that runs the state's organ, eye and tissue donor registry, announced in December the launch of a specialty license plate promoting organ, tissue and eye donation, the sales of which will benefit donation education in Florida and Florida's donor registry.

Before the plate goes into production Donate Life Florida must presell 3,000 vouchers to Florida motor vehicle owners. You may purchase a voucher online for \$33.

- Voucher purchasers will get a certificate to redeem for the actual plate, which will be produced once Donate Life Florida has sold 3,000 vouchers.
- Vouchers can only be purchased online or at tax collectors' offices at this time. Many offices are taking customers via appointment only, so please check with your county office for rules: www.FLHSMV.gov/locations.
- Vouchers are only available for motor vehicles only, and commercial vehicles weighing less than 26,001 pounds.

Back in 2019, the FOTA Board of Directors started planning a 2020 Education Forum to bring South Florida medical professionals, pharmaceutical companies and transplant families together to learn about the latest advancements in transplantation. While all in-person plans continue to be pushed out for the time being, we could wait no longer to offer educational programming, so we are proud to announce **Transplant Topics: Virtual Education Forum**.

Every quarter, you can expect an educational offering through Zoom. We kicked things off with Audra Hutton Lopez, Transplant Coordinator of Memorial Transplant Institute on March 31st as she presented about "Maintaining a Healthy Lifestyle Post-Transplant". Audra offered a simple, no-nonsense approach to taking care of your transplant for the long-term. Now for Donate Life Month, we are featuring CareDx and how to utilize their AlloCare App to track the care of your organ post-transplant. While the focus of the app began for kidney patients (84% of Floridians awaiting a transplant need a kidney, #kidneyawareness), the functionality lends itself across all transplanted organs. Transplant Recipient, Patty Scott, Writes about Resilience



Patty Scott is a familiar name to many in the South Florida transplant community. She was member of Team Florida for the Transplant Games, a regular at support group meetings, and coordinator of past Transplant Education Forums from 2002-2007, before moving to Indiana.

She has written a book about her transplant and overall health journey. Resilience: The story of surviving major medical challenges and living life to the fullest was published last July. The book started out as an evidence-based account of her research to help individuals facing the same sorts of medical challenges and persistent problems as she did (spinal cancer, two liver transplants, a medically induced coma and Cryptogenic Organizing Pneumonia). It became a memoir. It is a treasure for transplant candidates, recipients, and their families about how to weather the storms and emerge at the other end. Transplant Life Foundation, Transplant Games of America organizers, announced recently that the 2020 Transplant Games will be held virtually between April-July. The new format, "Honor the Journey... Coast to Coast", will take place in hometowns across the country, providing the Transplant Games of America with a unique opportunity to reinforce its mission to spread awareness about the importance of organ donation. Signature events will be produced and aired from New Jersey at

their regularly scheduled times with no live audience planned.

The following competitions will be offered with registered athletes competing in their hometowns and submitting scores. Competitions can take place between April 1, 2021 and July 1, 2021. They will be awarding a gold medal for every completed competition for which a valid score is submitted (a maximum 4 gold medals per participant).

Every individual registered will receive a commemorative gold medal in celebration of this unique one-of-a-kind event. Registrants will also be shipped a SWAG box that will include a souvenir credential, a modified program (TransplantNATION magazine), official 2020 commemorative t-shirt, TGA pin, and additional surprises as well.
